Director Erb called the meeting to order at 5:33 pm and declared a quorum.

The Board approved the agenda by acclamation with moving the financials up to the

beginning of the meeting.

Upon motion by Director Gelman and seconded by Director Draudt, the March 9, 2022

meeting minutes were approved 5-0.

Facility budget scope discussion

Scope, site plan and budget update

tion The baby pool was discussed with the Board. Tri-County is now requiring a fence around

the pool due to current code. Discussion followed. The Board would like Essenza to discuss the fence more with Tri-County officials to see what other options might be

available.

There is an area on one side of the pool where the coping stone is higher than the rest of the pool. It is recommended to raise the concrete in the area so the coping stone is flush.

Leaks in piping have been discovered under the pool decking. Discussion followed.

The pump room needs additional ventilation which would include some mechanical needs.

The entrance floor finishing was discussed to help reduce costs. Mr. Boucha is meeting with the concrete contractor to discuss options within the current budget and will provide updates for the next meeting.

Wireless keypads at the tennis courts were not recommended by the security contractor. It would have to be hard wired.

The construction timeline was reviewed with the Board. The sewer delays have pushed the timeline out a bit. Mr. Boucha discussed the project will be finished by mid to late June. FCI, Essenza and management will request to have a modified occupancy during the final phases of construction completion, if possible, so the swim team can begin practice one the lap pool is completed and safety features are ready for a limited amount of occupants.

The Board reviewed the financials for additional funds to source to some of these repairs. Discussion followed. All of the repairs and construction extension expenses total roughly \$32,000.

Upon motion by Director Erb and seconded by Director Gelman, the Board voted 5-0 to approve repairing concrete coping stone, leaks in piping for filters and skimmers and ventilation roughly estimated at \$32,000.
